The PDA-ESE modules, offered statewide, utilize quality online instruction for self-paced study, ongoing communication with local facilitator support, and classroom-related assessment tasks. Seven of the modules are worth 60 professional development points (or the equivalent of 3 credit hours for those teaching out-of-field), and one is worth 30 points. The Differentiating Reading Instruction module also satisfies competency 4 and 5 of the reading endorsement.
